

July 10 to 28, 2013 Baltic Cruise: London to St. Petersburg and back

We transfer to SFO, fly to London and transfer to Southampton to board the Crown Princess for a 14 day cruise of the North and Baltic Seas. We call at Oslo, Norway; Gothenburg, Sweden; Talinn, Estonia; then a two- day call in St Petersburg, Russia, capital of the Tsars and Venice of the North. We continue to Helsinki, Finland; Stockholm, Sweden; Copenhagen, Denmark; and Brussels, Belgium; returning to Southampton for transfer to our flight home. The cost will range from \$3950 for an interior stateroom to \$4795 or \$4890 for a balcony cabin, to \$5445 for a Mini Suite. Prices are per person double occupancy, not including air fare which is not yet available, but use of airline miles is allowed. For information or a brochure, call Jim or Roy.

September 7, 2013 (1 Day) America's Cup Finals We will board the Bay Celebration motor launch from Jack London Square for a cruise out to the boundary of the race course where we will watch the Oracle team defend the Cup against the winner of the Challenge Elimination Series. The first race is September 7th; we will go on multiple days if there is sufficient interest. Cost will be approximately \$160/person plus a possible extra charge (TBD) by the America's Cup organization. Cruise includes round trip transportation and a catered lunch. 


Homestead Lanes January 2013 Winter league

SIR Branch 62 Eighteen Hole Golf

Thanks to Tome Birley for running December. As of this writing, the weather is working out OK. For those who wimped out on Dec 3, you missed a good day for golf in Sunnyvale. Hopefully Deep Cliff will get a bigger turnout. During the rainy season, if there is a question whether or not we are playing the scheduled course, call the course to see if the tournament coordinator has cancelled the round.

A brief note on the technical side. Since your handicap is determined by your index and the course slope, the question is how is the index determined? When you post a score, it is compared to the course rating – not par. For example, the rating at Sunnyvale from the white tees is 67.6 and par is 70. Your score minus the rating is multiplied by the ratio of 113/slope (again that magic number 113). This determines your differential. OK, so now what. Stay tuned...

I want to thank all of you for helping out with the tournament process. I really don't mind the administrative stuff and I have already invested the time to learn all the systems. If you don't get on the signup sheet and want to play, call the tournament coordinator and he will get you in.


