MARIANI'S LUNCH INFORMATION

As you know, we now sell tickets for our monthly lunch at Mariani's (2500 El Camino Real, Santa Clara, CA 95051) and several questions have come up.

1. If at all possible, please buy your lunch ticket at the meeting preceding the one you plan to attend.

If you cannot buy your ticket for the next month at the luncheon or send your money to the Little Sir at least one week in advance (that's the Thursday before the meeting), then don't come to the meeting expecting to eat. 3.
