NOVEMBER SPEAKER

Our Speaker is Major General Rob Ostenberg, who joined the Army in 1969 as an enlisted soldier and later attended and graduated from Infantry Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, Ga. He transferred to the Armor Cavalry Branch in 1971. He then volunteered for duty in Vietnam, where he served as a Platoon Leader in the 1st Company of the 6th Infantry and later in the 1st Company of the 1st Cavalry. During his over 39year career, he served in every leadership position from Platoon Leader to Commanding General of a 14,000 soldier Division.

In his final assignment, he served as Director, Reserve Forces, with additional duty as one of five Domestic Attack Assessors in North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) and US Northern Command (USNORTHCOM) at Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado Springs, CO.

The talk is to honor the vets who served in Viet Nam. 2015 marks the 50^{th} anniversary of the ramp up of that conflict.

Tickets are sold in advance of the monthly lunch at Mariani⁷s (2500 El Camino Real, Santa Clara, CA 95051). If at all possible, please buy your lunch ticket at the meeting preceding the one you plan to attend. **Tickets for the January lunch will be sold at the November meeting.**
