April 20 or 27 – Ruby Hill Wine Tour and Tasting: Join us for a unique two-hour tour of the Ruby Hill Vineyards in Livermore on the Mello Cielo, a vintage school bus with 14 swivel chairs made of old wine barrels. Along the way, we will learn the history of Ruby Hill Winery, visit the modern on-site production facility, and see the wine making process from vine to bottle as undertaken by winemaker Jesse Plautz and his experienced cellar crew. Throughout the tour, we will sample a few of the current vintages as well as some still aging in the barrel. The culmination of the tour is a sit-down food and wine pairing at the historic water tower. This is a private tour for 8 to 14 people. We plan to go together in a 15-passenger van. The cost is expected to be \$60. A no host lunch in Livermore is also a possibility.
