


Fishing

April 6th – 18th, 2021: Paris to Normandy: We are going to try to re-initiate our cancelled trip from October of 2020. As before, we will travel from Paris, via Caen (visit the Peace Museum), to Honfleur and meet our river cruise ship. Tour the D-Day invasion beaches, American cemetery and other sites. Then cruise up the Seine calling at such places as Rouen, Les Andelys, Vernon, Giverny (Monet's Garden), Pontoise, and ending with 2 nights in Paris. We expect the cost to be around \$5200 to \$5700 pp double occ. (depending on cabin choice), including round trip air fare from San Francisco.
