Wed., June 24th 2020: Chinese Exhibit at Blackhawk Museum - Terra Cotta Warriors: We're planning a one- day bus trip to the Blackhawk Museum to visit their new "into China" gallery, containing Chinese items and art, including some of the Terra Cotta Warriors from Xi'an. The cost is expected to be \$132 for the bus trip, lunch at a restaurant in Blackhawk, and entrance to the museum. If we get more than the minimum number of participants (twenty), appropriate refunds will be made, as was done on the Beach Blanket Babylon trip. Watch for sign up details in future "Roosters" or call the travel chairmen.

Oct. 3rd – 15th, 2020: Paris to Normandy: Travel from Paris via Caen (visit the Peace Museum) to Honfleur and meet our river cruise ship. Tour the D-Day invasion beaches and American Cemetery and other sites. Then depart on a cruise up the Seine calling at such places as Rouen, Les Andelys, Vernon, Giverny (Monet's Garden), Pontoise, and ending with 2 nights in Paris. The cost is \$5275 to \$5675 per person double occupancy (depending on cabin choice), including round trip air fare from San Francisco. Single occupancy is sold out. A 4-night pre-trip to Brittany and Mont St. Michel for \$995 and a 3-night post trip in Paris for \$745 are available.
