Abstract of Minutes of Branch Executive Committee (BEC) 3-18-21

Big Sir: Wally Anderson: Opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Wally welcomed everyone to our Zoom BEC meeting. Wally said that he found around 500 SIR Business cards and has them available to give out to our members who would like them to give to anyone who is interested in joining SIR. He also said he sent in Senior Sir nominations for John Shields, John Steele, Bud Collinson and Warren Dunn. Wally said that our branch did a good job responding to the State SIR vaccine assistance email. Wally said Little SIR Leon Kowaleski is the vaccine assistance coordinator for our branch.

<u>Membership Chairman/Web Master: Heber Slusser</u>: Heber said that he thought it was a good idea to ask someone who is interested in SIR to join in on our zoom luncheons so they can see what we are about before trying to get them to become a member.

Treasurer Roger Falberg: Roger said that 43 members have paid their dues and is waiting on another 18 to be paid. He noted that there is \$2600.00 in adjusted balance in our account.
