#### **Abstract of Minutes of Branch Executive Committee (BEC) 2-18-21**

<u>Big Sir:</u> Wally Anderson: Opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Wally welcomed everyone to our Zoom BEC meeting. Wally brought up the idea of inviting guest to our Zoom meetings and weekly chats on Thursdays, as a way to recruit new members. Wally asked Tom Birley to give an update on SIR business cards that we can give out to people who may be interested in Sirs. Tom said he has them ready to give out to members. Heber Slusser asked Tom to send him one to look over before getting them out. Wally asked that we look at diversity when recruiting for new members.

Membership Chairman/Web Master: Heber Slusser: There was some discussion about activities not being reported on Form 27 each month. It was determined that the activities only need to be reported quarterly, and that only those activities that were done will be reported.
